BIO ENGLISH

Jeff started creating music in 1994 and got hooked on it directly, but it took until 1998 before his first single was to come out on his own label Maskros Music. Since that single he has released over 100 singles on labels like Poker flat, Episode, Treibstoff, Intrinsic design, Konvex Konkav, Jamayka, Morris audio, regular etc.

The first album “Jeff Bennett – Puzzling thoughts” was released in the beginning of the summer 2003 on Episode. It received wide recognition from many big name DJs.

The second album “Jeff Bennett – Endwise” was released 2006 on Plastic , also gained great support by many high profile DJs.

Kung Fu Dub Recordings is Jeff’s Tech-house/minimal label since 2001 and has releases/remixes onboard by artists like Terry Lee Brown JR, Jori Hulkkonen, Valentino

Out in February 2009 on BeatModul Rec from Germany is Jeff’s Third official Mix CD, containing tracks and remixes from Rui Da Silva, Terry Lee Brown JR, Kaiser Souza, Steve Nash, Da Fresh + many more.

The earliest influences came from Detroit people like Derrick May, Juan Atkins & Kevin Saunderson, but also from Richie Hawtin's label Plus 8 and the artist there like Speedy J, Kenny Larkin etc. Europe also had a big impact on him with artists like Stefan Roberts, 808 state, KLF, Dreadzone, Terry lee brown Junior, Thomas Schumacher, Tikiman & labels like Plastic City, Poker Flat, SVEK, Circulation, early Network releases + many more. Also a lot of Reggae & Dub artists like Augustus Pablo, Lee Perry, Mad Professor, Andy Horace, King Tubby, Barrington Levy + many more.

Jeff is currently finishing the recording of his third album under the Alias “Eddie Silverton” (Lounge/Lofi/Downbeat) it will be released on Deeplaymusic from Sweden and has already been licensed to many compilations. During 2009 Jeff will be recording his third album as Jeff Bennett, it should be finished after the summer.

And of course being a dj as well brings a lot of inspiration & impressions to ones music from all the different places he visits creating new vibes and sounds.

In 1994 he and a partner founded a record store called Cosmic One Records that became the first electronic record store in Malmo. With the opening of the record store the DJ career got a boost and he started playing on various venues.

A year after the store was opened Jeff & his record store partner Jim Groovy started making their own one-off parties and clubs in various sizes. His longest residency was in a house club called Thank God It's Friday were he played almost every Friday for over a year. He has played at clubs & parties like: Fabric (London), Otto Zutz (The edge, Barcelona), Fusion festival 2002 (Germany), Ostgut (Berlin), Terry’s cafe (Frankfurt),

PolarTV (Berlin), Barracca (Spain), The Loft (Spain) + many more.

In 1996 Jeff & Jim started their first label Azurite records. Jeff started his own label Maskros Music in 1998. And the year 2000 two new labels called Phunctional & Kung fu dub we're started by Jeff. The only label that is still alive from that era is Kung Fu dub, which has recently been frozen up from its 3year sleep with some nice upcoming releases and remixes.

After moving on from the record store Jeff decided to move to Oslo/Norway for new inspirations. After 6months of Norway the path towards Malmo/Sweden was once again the choice and this is the base of Jeff's whereabouts until further.

Jeff comenzó a crear música en 1994 y quedó prendido inmediatamente, sin embargo no fue hasta 1998 que su primer single fue editado en su propio sello Maskros Music. Desde ese momento ha lanzado mas de 100 singles en sellos como Poker Flat, Episode, Treibstoff, Intrinsic Design, Konvex Konkav, Jamayka, Morris Audio, Regular, etc.

En el 2001 Jeff lanzó Kung Fu Recordings, sello de minimal / tech-house en que ha editado originales y remixes a artistas como Terry Lee Brown Jr, Jori Hulkkonen y Valentino, entre muchísimos otros.

Actualmente está finalizando la grabación de su tercer album bajo el alias "Eddie Silverton" (Lounge/Lofi/Downbeat) que será lanzado en Deeplaymusic de Suecia y que ya ha sido licenciado para varias compilaciones. Por otro lado durante el 2009 Jeff va a grabar su tercer album como "Jeff Bennet", que debería estar finalizado luego del verano.

Su trabajo como DJ aporta mucha inspiración e impresiones a su música, desde todos los diferentes lugares que visita, creando nuevas vibraciones y sonidos.
